• <u>Pre-K - 2nd Grade</u>:

- Our goal is to support parents in providing a foundation of reading, writing and arithmetic for a lifelong love of learning and exploration. (Supplements sourced from multiple methodologies)
- **ELA and Math:** The Good & The Beautiful (TGTB) curriculum (to be used 3 days at home, 1 day at GLOW)

WHAT WE OFFER

• Teachers are expected to include games/learning activities, individualized learning opportunities to supplement and extend learning (in addition to teaching TGTB curriculum)

• <u>3rd - 6th Grade</u>:

- **History & Science:** TGTB curriculum- blending literature, interactive lessons, timeline, and historical connections.
- Project-Based Learning and Unit Studies for Science & Literature-based History (3rd 6th): Students acquire a deeper knowledge through active exploration of real world challenges and problems. Students will have opportunity to present projects. Students will grasp history through the very popular and highly reviewed Story of The World curriculum.
 - i. Socratic discussions to develop critical thinking through inquiry-led, shared dialog between teacher, students and peers
 - ii. Science Unit studies and hands-on exploration for deeper, meaningful learning
- Core subjects will need to be covered at home with desired curriculum

THE GOOD AND THE BEAUTIFUL CURRICULUM

- Covers all core subject areas (no gaps in phonics or math like some other curriculums)
- Uses several different philosophies/methods to teach (Charlotte Mason, classical, spiral, etc.), but pulls mainly from Charlotte Mason
- Option to print all lessons for free (excluding Preschool) <u>OR</u> purchase physical copy Emphasizes Biblical worldview, family, God, high character, nature, and wholesome literature
- "Open and Go" style: Requires no daily prep time—just open the book and follow the instructions, learning and exploring along with your child
- Family Style History, Science, & Electives: appropriate across all grades
- Lessons combine multiple subjects, which connects learning and eliminates the need for six to seven different courses
- Thorough phonics reading program- creates excellent readers
- Thorough and advanced courses-leave no gaps
- Offers a free book list for all ages

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

STEM Sparks is the perfect class for curious kids who love to build, create, and explore how things work. Designed with homeschoolers in mind, this hands-on class introduces early learners to engineering, robotics, and the foundations of coding.

Each week, your child will jump into exciting challenges like building simple machines, creating mini robots, or "programming" a classmate through fun, step-by-step activities. With a focus on movement, imagination, and real-world problem solving, STEM Sparks nurtures creativity and critical thinking in a playful, age-appropriate way.

Invent & Automate is a hands-on robotics and coding class where students turn ideas into action. Each week, they'll design, build, and program robots to solve fun, real-world challenges - learning the foundations of engineering, automation, and coding along the way.

Whether your child is completely new to tech or already curious about how things work, this class encourages creative problem-solving, critical thinking, and teamwork through engaging, beginner-friendly projects. No prior experience is needed - just a love for discovery and a willingness to explore!

<u>BACKGROUND</u>:

CLASS DESCRIPTION + PRICING:

Pre-K Foundational Reading Skills:

In this small group session, Pre-K aged students will learn foundational literacy skills through kinesthetic activities, shared reading, and interactive writing. Students will begin to learn letter names and sounds, letter formation, how to write their name, phonological awareness (including hearing syllables, rhymes, and beginning consonant sounds), and concepts of print (letter vs. word, punctuation, first/last letter or word, etc.).

<u>Cost</u>: \$180/semester 30 minute classes

Kindergarten Emergent Reading Skills:

In this small group session, Kindergarten aged students will continue to build their literacy skills through kinesthetic activities and guided reading & writing. Students will master letter sounds, engage in word work activities (to teach phonics & phonemic awareness), dive into guided writing (to teach basics of print and word/sentence formation), learn sight words, and practice reading strategies that will help them become successful readers.

• <u>Cost</u>: \$180/semester 30 minute classes

1st grade Early Reading Skills:

In this small group session, 1st grade aged students will learn to apply their foundational reading skills and strategies to solve more challenging words, read fluently, and display comprehension while reading. Students will continue to learn and apply more complex phonics skills & sight words in order to read and write longer words and sentences.

CLASS DESCRIPTION + PRICING:

Pre-K-2nd: Students will begin to build a foundation in introductory conversational Spanish. They will learn basic vocabulary, phrases, and expressions. They will learn through songs, activities, games, and imitating real-life situations.

<u>Cost</u>: \$6/30 min class <u>Semester</u> total: \$90

3rd-6th grade: Students will start to form a solid foundation in beginner Spanish. Students will practice all four modes of communication: speaking, listening, reading, and writing. They will enjoy a highly-immersive classroom experience, with most of the class taking place in Spanish, with minimal English used. Students will learn vocabulary, expressions, and basic grammar with culture, history, and geography mixed in.

<u>Cost:</u> \$12/60 min class <u>Semester total</u>: \$180

Middle School-High School: Students will go through the entire Spanish 1 level in two semesters with weekly hour-and-a-half classes plus at-home practice. Students will learn foundational vocabulary and grammar, as well as history, geography, and culture. Students will participate in a highly Spanish-immersive classroom, with minimal English used, allowing them to grow in Spanish comprehension and fluency. Note: This course requires curriculum purchase.
